# REOPENING PROTOCOLS

Please note that the following protocols are in effect as of June 20, 2021. Given the fluidity of the situation, we anticipate easing restrictions as rapidly as possible while still prioritizing the health and safety of our membership. Please consult your weekly bulletin for the most current guidelines and recommendations.

## CURRENT HEALTH PROTOCOLS:

**MEMBERS, CAREGIVERS, GUESTS AND VISITORS ARE WELCOME TO ATTEND,  
WITH PROOF OF VACCINATION.**

- **ALL ATTENDEES MUST BE FULLY VACCINATED.** Proof of vaccination (original vaccination card or a photo copy) **MUST** be presented on your first return visit to Beth Shalom.

**PLEASE DO NOT PUT US IN AN AWKWARD POSITION OF HAVING TO TURN YOU AWAY.**

- **ALL ATTENDEES WILL BE REQUIRED TO SIT SOCIALLY-DISTANCED**, unless they reside in the same household.
- **FACE MASKS ARE OPTIONAL**, since all attendees will be fully vaccinated. Because we share our facility, we strongly recommend wearing face masks when in the parking lot and when using the restrooms.
- Kiddush and other food items will **NOT** be served at this time. Bottled water will be available.
- If you have traveled internationally, we ask that you **NOT** attend services until you have self-quarantined for a 14-day period.

As we adapt throughout this period of transition, we request that everyone remain sensitive and compassionate toward one another. We recognize that each individual has their own personal comfort level in regard to removing masks, handshakes, touch, distance, and more. All choices are to be respected and for many reasons one should not inquire as to why someone is choosing to wear a mask or maintain distance from others.

## CURRENT RITUAL PROTOCOLS:

- **SERVICES WILL BEGIN PROMPTLY AT 10:00 AM AND WILL BE BROADCAST SIMULTANEOUSLY.** Congregants in the sanctuary **AND** viewing the broadcast will count toward the *minyan*. At this time services will continue to be abbreviated.
- *Siddurim* and *humashim* will be at each seating station.  
Please do **NOT** return books to the shelves.
- Only service leaders will be allowed on the *bimah*.
- *Aliyot* will be assigned by the service leader and blessings will be recited from your seat.
- We encourage you to bring your own *kippah* and *tallit*.
